ORDER

Government vide order read as first paper above have issued orders for implementing Seventh UGC pay revision to Teachers in Universities, Affiliated Colleges, Teachers in Law Colleges and Engineering Colleges and Kerala Agricultural University, Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean studies and Teachers in Physical Education and qualified Librarians etc.

2. The University Grants Commission vide Notification read as second paper above have furnished UGC Regulations, 2018 on Minimum qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve and to implement the Regulations as such.

3. The Regulations shall come into force with effect from 18/7/2018, i. e. the date of publication of the Regulations in the Government of India Gazette (Extra Ordinary).

4. All the Universities shall ensure incorporation of the UGC Regulations in their Statutes and Regulations within one month from the date of this order. Government will initiate steps to amend the Acts of the University, if required to implement the Regulations. Government will also initiate steps to amend the Special Rules to give effect to the stipulations of the UGC Regulations.

5. Government are also pleased to order that where there are any provision in the Regulations inconsistent with the provisions in the Government Order read as first paper above, those provisions in the Government Order would over ride the provisions in the Regulations to the extent of such inconsistency.

6. Government are also order that not withstanding anything contained in the Regulations only those benefits both monetary and others specified in the Government Order read as first paper above would be receivable.
